- MOTIONS: Approval of October SAC meeting minutes: Motion by Carol Bernich, Second by Ashley Siner; Approved.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Meeting begins with Joe Jannazo welcoming SAC. Share there is a short agenda but a lot of great information to share in the short meeting. Thanks SAC members for being there. Hands meeting over to Ms. Bethea.
- Ms. Bethea asked that everyone take a moment to review the SAC Meeting Minutes from the October SAC meeting if they have not had the chance.
 - o MS. BERNICH make a motion to approve October SAC Meeting Minutes
 - o MS. SINER seconds
 - o MS. BETHEA asks for vote (Yeas – 16, Nays- 0)
- Dr. Hale shares Quarterly Review information:
 - o It is part of a principal's evaluation to gauge the temperature of the school's academic climate. It is more specifically an evaluation of the schools implementation of its SPP (School Performance Plan).
 - o It was completed differently this year and the process limited the number of classrooms we were able to visit. Due to the immediate debrief sessions with District Staff and Admin in the hallways after exiting an observed classroom, fewer classrooms were able to be visited, but a more in-depth discussion was had in regards to initiative implementation.
 - o We were able to visit 3 ELA, 1 IR, 1 IM, 1 Algebra, 1 US Hist, and 1 Bio
 - o We (admin) continue to have conversations with staff and know the great things happening in the classrooms.
 - o District Comments:
 - First high school visited but set the bar very high

- Evident growth from last year
- Teachers are showing ownership- (Hale comment- This is really Big for us and our teachers. This shows real implementation of the SPP initiatives instead of just checking a box. Teachers are working hard and it takes a lot of effort to meet the students where they are as individuals to move them forward)
- Evident crafting of purposeful lessons with creative implementation
- “It’s really happening at Choctaw”
- Teacher of the Year – Hilary Brown
 - Jannazo shared that the TOY was voted by teachers and staff.
 - Ms. Brown does everything from social media and technology to the school television/broadcasting program.
- Semester exam schedule
 - Schedule was sent to district that was similar to last year’s exam schedule. All exams will be completed before holiday break. There will be three (3) days of early release.
 - Dr. Hale stated that when other schools heard how Choctaw scheduled exams last year, they followed suit.
- Principal’s business (Dr. Hale)
 - Winter sports have kicked off – busy season
 - Boys soccer has started
 - Girls Volleyball team was headed to state championship.
- Sheryl Murphy announced an initiative with Healthy Schools and implementing a food-filled backpack program. Some kids will receive food and backpacks at the beginning of December.
- Meeting adjournment was motioned by Dr. Lee Hale, Seconded by Bernich, and approved.
