Program Hours

After-school Program hours are determined by your child's school

- Baker 2:30-4:55
- Edwins 3:00-5:25
- Elliot Point 2:30-4:55
- Wright 3:00-5:25
- **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE-Dismissal from the program after 3 late pick-ups.**
- The program will be closed on official school holidays, teacher workdays, and/or inclement weather days, as announced by the Superintendent of Schools.
- Busing is provided. An adult **MUST** meet the student at the bus stop every day.

Sign-Out Procedures

- Students will use an electronic to sign in and out.
- **Be ON TIME to pick up your child(ren) or to meet them at the bus**
- Only persons authorized in writing by you, the parent/guardian may remove your child from the program. The staff members may request photo identification if the person picking up the child is unfamiliar. Please be aware we do this for the safety of your child. The A.S.P.I.R.E. Program will not release your child without a prior written notice and/or a phone call. If the child is not picked up on time, and the site supervisor has not been notified of the emergency, the same procedures that are School Board approved will be followed.



Attendance

Attendance is required daily of all children attending the after school program. The child is expected to stay until the end of the program daily.

Parents/Guardians are responsible for notifying the site coordinator if their child will be absent from the program, if they have attended school that day. Absences from the program are allowable for the same reasons as school. This is NOT a drop off program. Funding for this grant is dependent upon regular attendance.

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Discipline

Proactive guidance focuses on preventing problems by providing students with meaningful, positive feedback.
