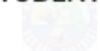

Covid 19

- We are working to provide as much distance as possible between students.
- Each desk has a privacy shield. Even with that, students should be prepared to wear masks. (Masks are required for bus riders)
- Faceshields have been provided for teachers to use during small group instruction.
- We will clean all high traffic areas as much as possible throughout the day.
- Each classroom doorway is equipped with a hand sanitizer dispenser.
- Students can use water fountains to refill the water bottles they bring each day but should not drink from the fountains.
- We will work to keep homeroom groups together as much as possible to minimize cross contamination.
- We expect students to take part in keeping their own areas clean throughout the day.

Buses!

Updated Bus Route information is now available at www.okaloosaschools.com

Since we cannot maintain 6 ft distancing on the bus, all students must wear a mask. Siblings and those in the same household should be prepared to sit together on the bus. We will have assigned seats to assist with contact tracing.
