### DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Approval of March SAC minutes with correction made to change Dawn Brown to Don Brown. Motion by Bernich, second by Wolfkeil.
- AICE testing
  - o Mr. Jannazo discussed AICE testing scheduled for May 8. Over 400 students will be testing and the need for proctors was discussed. Mr. Jannazo asked volunteers to get with Ms. White if they were interested.
  - o Ms. Siner shared the website for Signup Genie for AP testing. She said she would add AICE testing to the sign up Genie and this would be mailed out to SAC members.
  - o Ms. Bethea mentioned having snacks for students before testing as discussed in the prior meeting. Dr. Hale shared that may be taken care of and we were trying to have something for the students after the test also.
- Chairwoman Bethea discussed Teacher Appreciation week in May and Teacher Appreciation Day (May 7).
  - o Teacher appreciation week is May 7-11
  - o Plans are underway for meal prep using the same caterer as last year
  - o Mentioned meeting for those interested in helping with Teacher appreciation immediately after SAC meeting adjourns
  - o Goal is to have a definitive plan by the end of next week for approval by Dr. Hale

- Ms. Wolfkeil mentioned maybe students could volunteer time to help with luncheon for community service hours. It was shared that the most help would be needed for clean up after the luncheon and for set up on May 9 the day before the luncheon.
- Ms. Bethea asked what items might be needed by teachers. Dry erase markers, paper towels, Clorox wipes paper towels and the like were all mentioned
- Principal's business, Dr. Hale
  - Hale added that students just finished the first round of state testing. There were a few invalidations from cell phones. He praised teachers for their hard work in the classrooms, especially without support at home for some students. He stressed the importance of attendance, as well.
  - Ms. Reagan was given recognition for IB art show and the acceptance from the builders association
  - Acknowledgement of assistant principal's week – lunch will be provided to assistant principals
  - State testing begins in earnest next week and teachers are currently working on “game day” preps. Choctaw students are visiting two local elementary schools to help them get excited and pepped up for their upcoming tests. Band, cheerleaders and basketball players will go visit these students.
  - Lots of events coming in the near future to include: Prom, Senior trip, Honors assemblies, Spring Sports, AP/IB tests, EOC, graduation, and baccalaureate
  - We will begin working on school performance plan soon including PD for teachers and strategies to be used in the classroom
  - Letter from superintendent regarding school funding was discussed. Discussed 1% growth in base student allocation. However many of the mandates coming from legislation do not include funding so we may still be underfunded.
  - Wolfkeil asked about summer school dates and she was told they will be forthcoming but she should expect similar dates to last year.
  - Bernich discussed Go Greek Emerald coast – for senior girls interested in sorority
  - Junior class representative discussed DoughLish fundraiser Saturday from 1-6
  - Adjourn: motion Hale, Second Bernich
