PHYSICALS AND IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATES 30 DAY EXEMPTIONS

Florida Statutes, Section 1003.22

_____ GRADE

Florida Law (F.S. 1003.22) requires that each child, who is entitled to initial entrance into a Florida Public School, must present a certification of a school-entry medical examination, performed within 1 year, prior to enrollment in school. Students shall be exempt from this requirement upon written request of the parent or guardian stating objections on religious grounds. Students will be allowed **30 school days** to obtain the required medical examination. If a student does not bring a certificate of medical examination to school within the specified period of time, he/she will be temporarily excluded from attending school until the certificate is presented.

Florida Statutes, Section 1003.22 and Department of Health regulations require that each student in attendance at a public school have on file the Florida Certificate of Immunization for the prevention of the following communicable diseases: Poliomyelitis, Diphtheria, Rubeola (Measles), Rubella, Pertussis, Mumps, Tetanus and other communicable diseases as determined by rules of The Department of Health.

Students transferring into Okaloosa County from another county in Florida, students that are military dependents, homeless students and DJJ students will be allowed thirty (30) **school days** to bring the required Certificate of Immunization to school. Students who do not bring a Certificate of Immunization to school within the 30 day period will be temporarily excluded from attendance at school until the required certificate is obtained.

Students may obtain the required Certificate of Immunization from their family physician, military hospital, or the Florida Department of Health in Okaloosa County, located at 221 Hospital Drive in Fort Walton Beach or 810 James Lee Road in Crestview.
