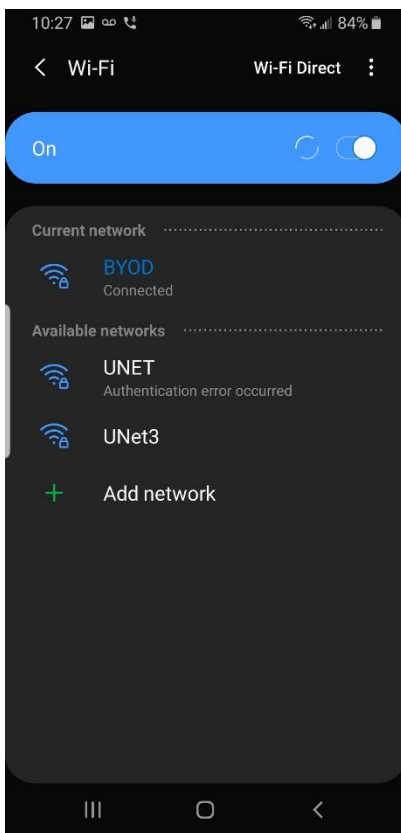
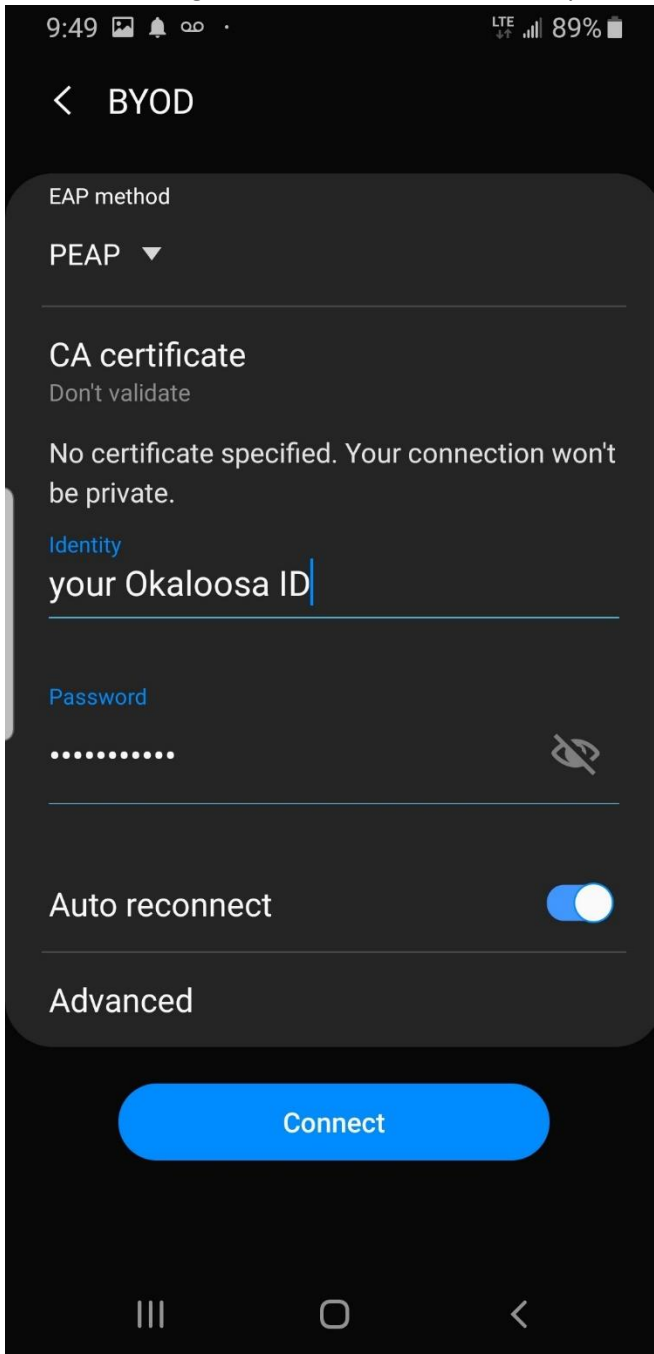


HOW TO: Connect BYOD Android devices to OCSD Network.

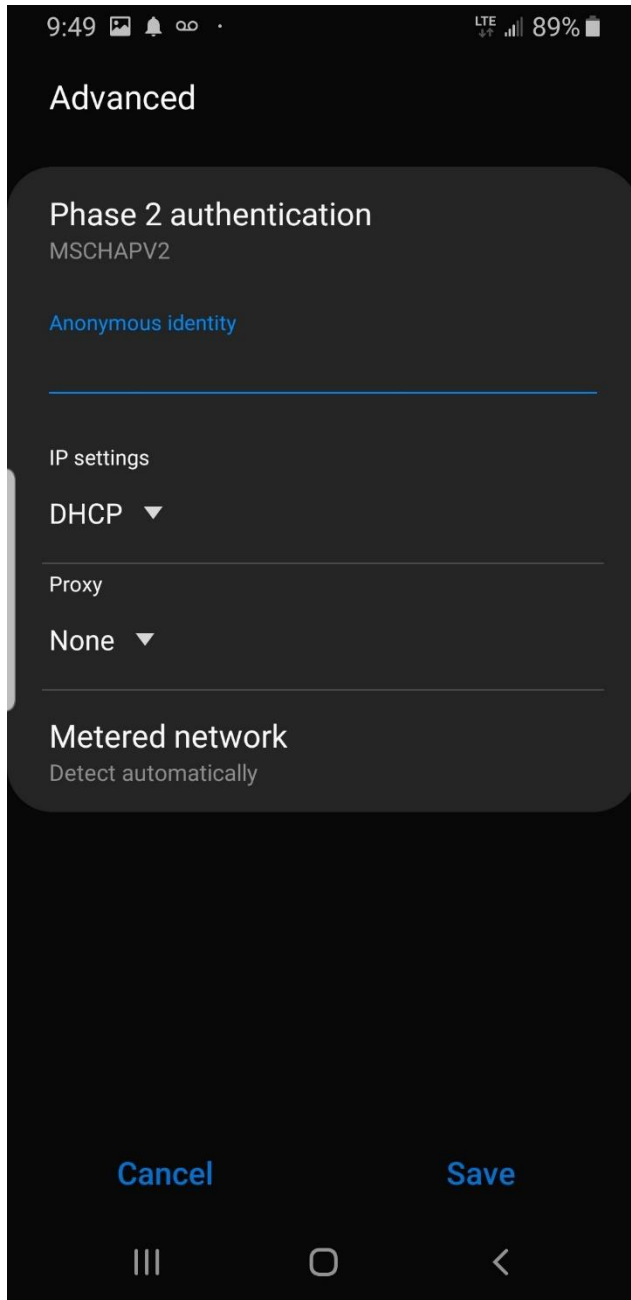
1. To connect a BYOD Android device to the OCSD Network, please follow the following steps.
2. Open Settings and press Wi-Fi.
3. Select the BYOD network.



4. Enter the settings listed below, and then enter your Okaloosa ID and password.

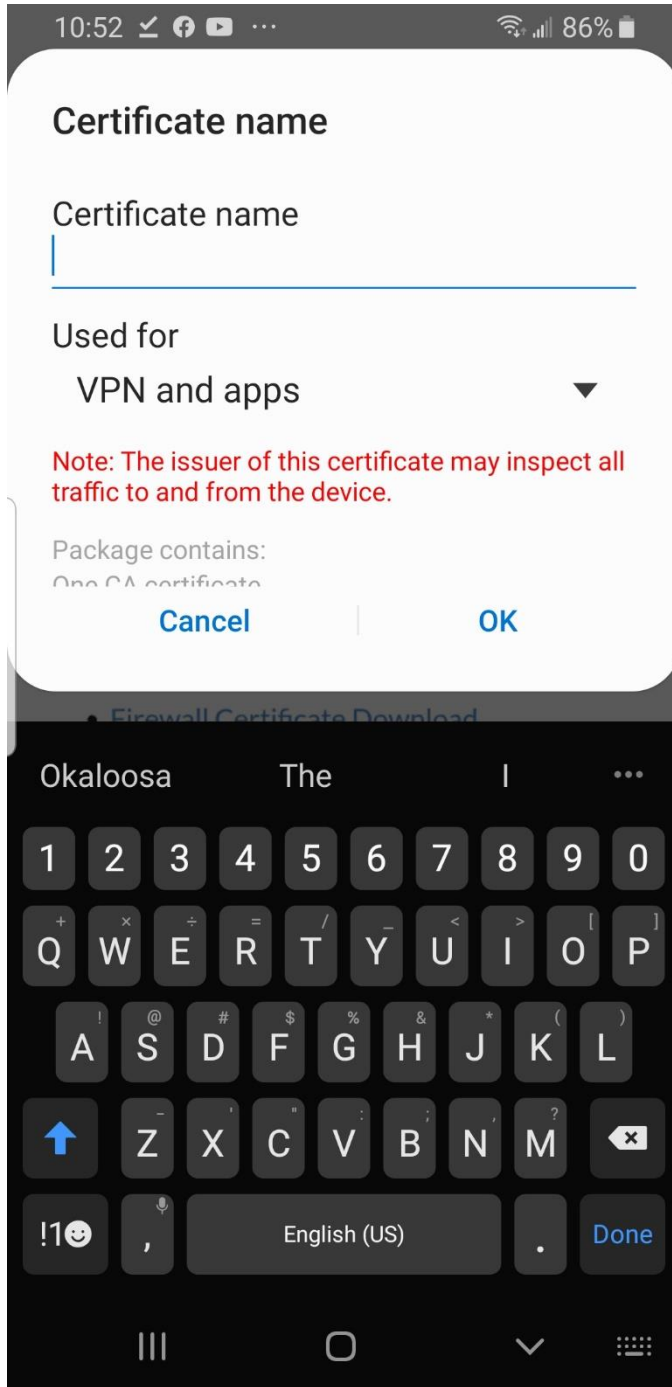


5. Click on Advance.



6. Under Phase 2 authentication, select MSCHAPV2 and then click on Save.
7. You should be connected to the "BYOD" network.
8. The Next Step is to connect to the OCSD's website and install the Certificate to be able to access the Internet. Go to <https://www.okaloosaschools.com/depts/tech/internet-access>
9. Click the Firewall Certificate Download link.

- When the Certificate opens, it may have the Certificate name blank. Enter Okaloosa Schools under the name and hit OK.

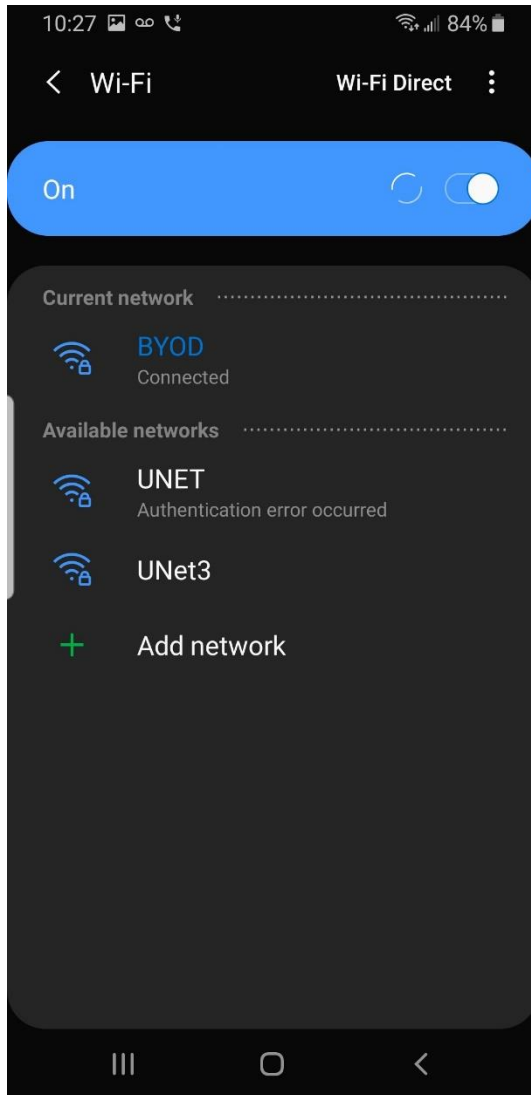


- You should be connected to the Internet now.

****Note****

When you change your password for OCSD, you will need to forget the BYOD network and go through these steps again so your password will be updated on the device. The steps to do this are as follows:

1. Click on the "BYOD" network.



2. Select and hold on "BYOD" then select "Forget network".
