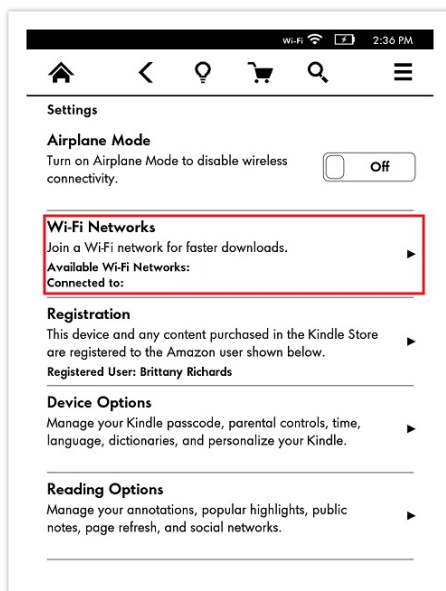


# HOW TO: Connect BYOD Kindle to OCSD Network

1. On the Kindle, Open the menu option by tapping the menu button in the upper right hand corner then select “Settings”

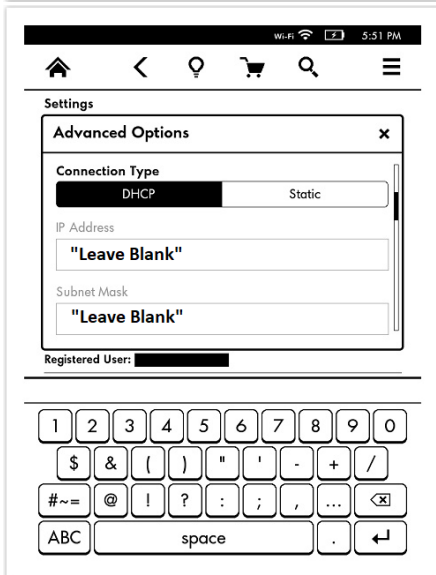
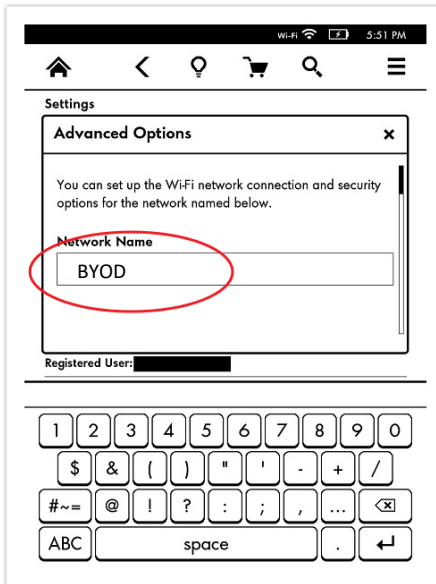


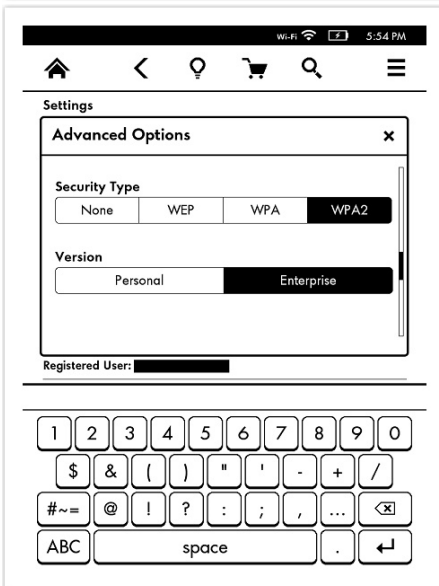
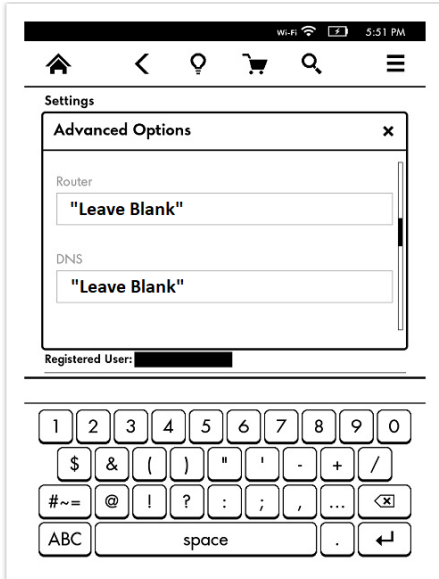
2. Select “WI-FI Networks”

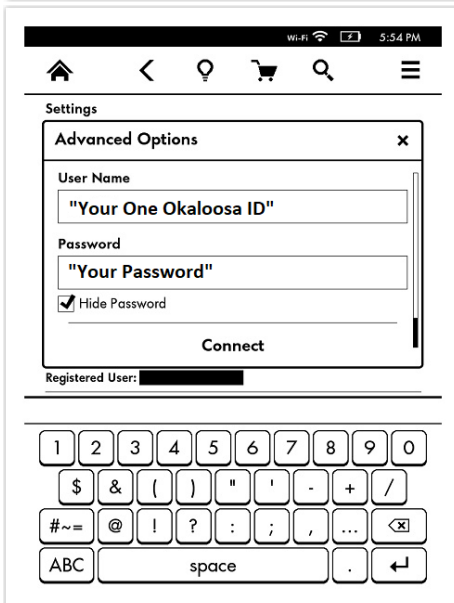
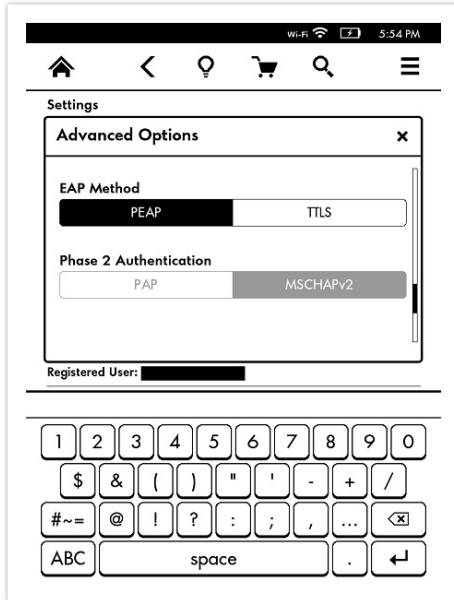


3. Select BYOD
4. Enter your One Okaloosa ID and password then click “Connect”

5. If the connection fails, Tap “Setup” and ensure the following settings are configured







**NOTE:** There is a chance that the device will state that it was unable to connect even when it has. Please check the WIFI icon, if it is lit up, the device is connected.

6. You will also need to install the Firewall certificate on the device. This certificate can be downloaded from <https://www.okaloosaschools.com/depts/tech/internet-access> by clicking on the Firewall Certificate link.
7. Go to settings on the Kindle and tap "Security and Privacy" then tap "Credential Storage"
8. Tap Install from device or SD Card.
9. Find the downloaded certificate and install it. If asked, install as Trusted Root Authority.
