- (d) authorize and execute consent for any and all medical and hospital care and treatment, including major surgery, deemed necessary by a duly licensed physician selected by my Attorney-in-Fact for the health, benefit and well-being of my child/children named herein.

Unless sooner revoked or terminated by me, this Special Power of Attorney shall become NULL and VOID from on and after the official **END OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL YEAR** for this enrollment, and in any case, this Special Power of Attorney will be effective **NO LONGER THAN ONE YEAR** from the date of its execution.
