EXPANDED FOOD SERVICE DURING SCHOOL CLOSURES

Meal service for all school-age children is expanding beginning Wednesday, March 25 with the establishment of four additional school feeding sites and a total five bus routes into neighborhoods to provide meals to students using Grab and Go. - State food service guidelines require the student to be present in order for meals to be distributed.
- When a parent arrives at a meal site, they will be able to receive up to two meals for the day for each student they bring to the site (breakfast and lunch).
- Students may pick up meals for themselves without a parent present.
