Okaloosa County Schools Closed

Governor Rick Scott has ordered the closing of all K-12 public schools, state colleges, and universities in order to prepare for impacts from Hurricane Irma. Okaloosa County Schools will be closed from Friday, September 8 through Monday, September 11.

All extracurricular activities and after school activities are cancelled for the weekend.

Please see Governor Scott's closure message (made the evening of Thursday, September 7):

Governor Scott said, "Today, I am directing the closure of all public schools, state colleges, state universities and state offices for their normal activities effective Friday through Monday, to ensure we have every space available for sheltering and staging. Floridians are facing a life-threatening storm in Hurricane Irma, and every family must prepare to evacuate. Our state's public schools serve a vital role in our communities as shelters for displaced residents and staging areas for hurricane recovery efforts. Closing public schools, state colleges, state universities and state offices will provide local and state

emergency officials the flexibility necessary to support shelter and emergency response efforts.”

Support Needed for Older Adult Evacuees Being Temporarily Housed at Bob Hope Village and Hawthorn House

Shalimar, Florida (September 7, 2017) – Assisted living and memory care residents and staff members who must evacuate due to Hurricane Irma will be temporarily housed by the Air Force Enlisted Village (AFEV) at Bob Hope Village and Hawthorn House in Shalimar.

The first group will arrive late tonight/tomorrow and the others throughout the weekend.

The local community is asked to provide assistance for the older adults with donations.

Due to strict state health codes and dietary restrictions, homemade food items cannot be accepted.

Monetary gifts are needed most to purchase the necessary food and supplies for the evacuees' care that may last up to 10 days.

Donations of all sizes are appreciated and \$5 or \$10 will go a long way to help. Donations can be made at www.afev.us/give (please send an email to info@afev.us to note your gift is for the Irma evacuees). Donations can also be dropped off at or mailed to Air Force Enlisted Village Headquarters, 92 Sunset Lane, Shalimar, FL 32579.

At this time, the following specific items will be accepted at Bob Hope Village Commons, 30 Holly Ave., Shalimar, FL:

- Bottled water
- Bladder control products of all sizes for men and women
- Baby wipes
- Paper towels
- Disposable plates, cups, utensils and cutlery
- Small and large trash bags

AFEV is working with the Okaloosa County Health Department, Florida Assisted Living Association, and the Agency for Health Care Administration to provide shelter for assisted living residents being evacuated.

Parents are reminded that a student has **5 days** from the day they return from an absence to excuse the absence. To excuse an absence, a parent is requested to send a note with the student to attendance. When an absence is unexcused, the student may not make up any work or tests in the class periods they were absent.

More Attendance Office Info:

If a parent gets a phone call from FWBHS about an absence and their student says they were in class, the student needs to check with that class period teacher and have the teacher email the attendance office that the student was in class. Attendance cannot remove an absence from the computer without the teacher verifying whether the student was actually in class or not.

If a student actually missed the class, they will have needed to checkout or check-in (and have the dismissal slip) or have a note for an all-day absence. If a student has missed a class during the day, they must check in upon arriving at school. If they need to leave, they must bring a note to checkout and receive a checkout slip in the attendance office before leaving campus. **Leaving campus during the day without a checkout slip is the equivalent of skipping.** Checkout slips cannot be issued after the fact.

- The FFAA will provide a User ID and password to each applicant upon submitting the application via the Saved Results Page and in an e-mail communication.**

The cumulative weighted grade point average is used to calculate honors graduation designation. At the end of the seventh semester, honors graduates will be determined by the following cumulative scale:

Summa Cum Laude – 4.25 and above

Magna Cum Laude – 4.0-4.2499

Cum Laude – 3.75-3.99

In order to be considered an honors graduate, students must be enrolled in the same year-long course at the same level and receive a grade for the eighth semester.
