Welcome to Laurel Hill School. We look forward to offering your child an exceptional education experience and wonderful memories for the rest of his/her life.

In order to register your child for Kindergarten, **your child must be 5 years old on or before September 1.**

Only parents or legal guardians may register a student. Identification will be required at the time of registration. Legally, in the state of Florida, if only one parent enrolls a child that parent is the only one who may withdraw the child. All Legal Guardians will be required to provide court documents showing guardianship.

Parents choosing to apply for Controlled Open Enrollment must do so by visiting www.okaloosaschools.com and clicking on the Controlled Open Enrollment link. Controlled Open Enrollment allows a parent from any district in Florida to enroll and transport his or her student to any public school that has not reached capacity. Out of State parents will also need to fill out the Controlled Open Enrollment Application for enrollment.

The following documents **must** be provided at the time of registration in order to enroll your child.

- **Proof of Residency** See MIS 5424
- **Certified Birth Certificate** (verification purposes)
- **Social Security Card** (verification purposes)
- **Driver's License of registering parent/guardian** (verification purposes)
- **Complete Immunization Record on Florida form DH 680**
A child who transfers into the district will be given 30 days to provide the proper immunization form. If at the end of the 30 day exemption period the parent fails to present a proper immunization certificate, the student will be excluded from school until the proper immunization certification has been provided.
This does not pertain to Pre K and Kindergarten students, who must meet all immunization requirements before being enrolled in a school. Florida State law, FS1003.22
- **Physical Examination on Florida form DH 3040**
(Administered within the last 12 months from the first day of school)
Without such certification, a medical appointment slip from a licensed physician must be provided signifying the child will have a physical exam within 30 days of the first day of school. If a physical exam is not provided after 30 days, the student will be excluded from school until proof of a physical exam form is provided. Florida State law, FS1003.22
