Immunizations Schedule

Kindergarten

- Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (4/5 doses)
- Hepatitis B (3 doses)
- M e a s l e s - M u m p s - Rubella (2 doses)
- Polio (4 doses)
- Varicella (Chickenpox) — either vaccine or history of disease documented by health care provider (2 doses)

7th grade

- Tetanus-Diphtheria-acellular Pertussis (Tdap)
- HPV (two doses 6 months apart)
