



**Immunizations for “Back-to-School” will be available by APPOINTMENT ONLY between July 1-September 1, 2017 at the Fort Walton Beach and Crestview clinics of the Florida Department of Health in Okaloosa**

- July 1-September 1 is the peak time for the annual “School Rush” and influx of families moving to the Emerald Coast. In an effort to provide the best possible customer service in an accurate, orderly, and efficient manner we have opted to provide immunization services on an appointment-only basis during those times.
- Requests for DH Form 680, Florida Certification of Immunization (AKA “Blue Cards” and “Shot Records”) will be available via *written request* at the Fort Walton Beach Immunization Clinic Monday-Wednesday between the hours of 7:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. and Fridays 7:30 a.m.-2:00 p.m. with pick-up available after 3 business days.
- Requests for DH Form 680, Florida Certification of Immunization (AKA “Blue Cards” and “Shot Records”) will be available via *written request* at the Crestview Immunization Clinic Monday-Thursday between the hours of 7:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. and Fridays between 7:30 a.m. -2:00 p.m. with pick-up available after 3 business days.
- Parents may also obtain a copy of their child’s DH Form 680 by going to <https://www.flshots.com/flshots/html/GetForm680.html> and entering their child’s state immunization ID and PIN number that is provided to parents in writing at each immunization encounter.
