GPA / CLASS RANK:

Class rank is based on all courses and all students. GPA is based on a 4.0 scale with an extra 1.0 quality point awarded for Advanced Placement, AICE, gifted, dual enrollment courses, and some IT courses. Honors courses receive a .5 extra quality point.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT, AICE AND HONORS

CURRICULUM:

Twenty-three Advanced Placement and ten AICE courses are offered in the areas of English, mathematics, science, social studies, foreign language, physical education and other electives totaling over 114 weighted honors, gifted and advanced-level courses throughout the curriculum. Dual enrollment courses are offered through an articulation agreement with a local college. All courses are available to any student willing to accept the challenge.
